LLUH provides a safety-net for our community. Programs that support our ability to care for the region’s most vulnerable populations are vital. In FY 2020, LLUH saved \$33.19 million due to participation in the 340b pharmaceutical discount program (LLUMC \$28.18M; LLUCH \$5.01M). These savings support our hospital’s operations so that LLUH can steward the scarce federal dollars to provide care to the region’s most vulnerable populations.
