



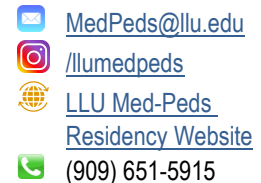

Application Process: via ERAS:

- We look at all the information within the application and then decide which candidates could be a good fit for our program. If there are any concerns or no contact from our program, please reach out to us.

Number and types of letters of recommendation:

- 3 letters of recommendation are required; no more than 4 are allowed.
- Department/chair letters are not required. We prefer letters to be written by writers that can speak to your clinical skills and character.

Application review/invite timeline:

- Applications are available for review by residency programs 09/29/2021.
- Your application should be as complete as possible by 09/29/2021. We plan to start to review applications that same day and will offer interview invitations shortly thereafter. We plan to interview from October through mid-December.

Approach to Step 1: Should have completed by time application submitted.

**Approach to Step 2 CK: Should have been completed by time rank list is due for the match.
USMLE Step 2 CS testing is suspended until at least June 2022.**

There are no absolute minimum cutoffs for the above scores as we take into consideration the entire application.
