Application to the Osteopathic Medical Board of California for PTL

Step-by-Step Guide for PTL

NOTE: The following guide applies to osteopathic medical school graduates that have matched into a California program for their **first** year of ACGME or AOA training.

A Postgraduate Training License (PTL) is a license issued by the Board that authorizes an individual to participate in an ACGME or AOA accredited training in California.

To be eligible for a PTL, the applicant must be enrolled in an approved ACGME or AOA accredited postgraduate training program in California, have received all of their medical education from, and graduated from, a recognized osteopathic medical school, taken and passed examinations recognized by the Board.

DO NOT DELAY!

- You may apply for a PTL as soon as you have graduated from medical school, completed COMLEX Level 1, and received confirmation of acceptance into an ACGME or AOA accredited postgraduate training program in California.
- A PTL must be obtained within 180 days after enrollment in an ACGME or AOA accredited postgraduate training program in California.
- The PTL will be valid for 15 months of postgraduate training if the resident will be enrolled in an ACGME or AOA accredited postgraduate training program in California.
- Must have passed at minimum Level 1 of the NBOME examination to be issued a PTL.
- Residents doing a short rotation in California are required to obtain a PTL even if a rotation is as short as 2 weeks.
 Residents must obtain a PTL to participate in the rotation.
 There is no guest license.
- You do not need to renew the PTL.
- PTL Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)
- Optional: You can obtain a DEA certificate once your PTL is issued. The sooner your PTL is issued, the sooner you can obtain your DEA certificate, and the sooner you can write orders.

STEP A

If you apply prior to your start date, submit documents **directly to OMBC.** If you are located locally, you can submit the following documents **directly to the GME Office** no later than August 31, 2022 to ensure enough time for processing:

- A. Application for PTL (Form OMB.22)
- B. Live Scan Fingerprinting Form
- C. Photocopy of Medical School Diploma
- D. Postgraduate Training License Enrollment Form (Form OMB.23)

PTL application fee of **\$491.00** is eligible for reimbursement out of your \$1000 Educational Fund if it is paid for **after your official start date**. The PTL application information and checklist can be viewed at this link: https://ombc.ca.gov/licensees/ptla_inst.pdf.

Submit Application to GME Office: Form OMB.22 can be downloaded **here**.

<u>OR</u>

Submit Application Online: Register for <u>BreeZe</u> Online Services and you <u>must</u> by mail to the Board: 1. Signed, notarized <u>Form</u> <u>OMB.26</u>, with your photo attached.

Please Note:

- Complete the forms on your PC and print the completed forms to ensure legibility. GME Office provides notary service for your application.
- Page 1 #7: Be sure to enter an email address you check frequently for correspondences from the Board.
- Page 3 #18-25: Please consult with GME Office if you are unsure how to answer.
- You need three identical 2x2 inch passport size photos for your PTL application.:
 - Affixed to page 6 of Form OMB.22
 - Affixed to page 1 of Form OMB.23
 - One loose photo sent with Form OMB.22

Find a Live Scan Location

The Live Scan Operator will complete the Live Scan form and keep one copy. Submit the second copy to the OMBC along with your application. The third copy is for you to keep for your records

If applicable: Applicants residing outside California must use the manual fingerprint card process. Contact OMBC at (916) 928-8390 OR e-mail osteopathic@dca.ca.gov to request and obtain fingerprint cards. **Results from the manual process can take up to 16 weeks.**

Medical School Transcript and Diploma

- Request your medical school to send an official paper copy of your transcript
- Submit a photocopy of your medical school diploma along with Form OMB.22.
- If you're not sure who to contact for the official paper copy of your transcript, start with the Registrar's Office.

Form OMB.23 and Form OMB.25

- Form OMB.23: Proof of enrollment in a Board approved AOA or ACGME accredit postgraduate training program is required. Fill out applicant information and signature, then give original form to GME Office (in-person or by mail) to complete remainder of the form and send directly to the MBC.
- Form OMB.25 (if applicable): This form is only necessary if there is prior postgraduate training. This form must be completed for each year of postgraduate training (internship, residency, and fellowship) completed, whether or not the entire residency was completed. Complete the personal data at the top of the form and submit to the prior program.

STEP B

- Submit an <u>online request</u> to have your official NBOME scores (At minimum: Level 1) sent directly to the OMBC.
- Wait until you have passed Level 1, but...
- Do not wait to submit the PTL application to the board.
 Apply now and send the scores later.
