In 2024, LLUH saved \$68.95 million through its participation in the 340B pharmaceutical discount program (LLUMC \$59.75M; LLUH \$8.75M; LLUMC-Murrieta \$455K). These savings help support LLUH hospitals, enabling LLUH to steward scarce federal dollars and to provide care to the region's most vulnerable populations.
