- Who are we?
 - Attending physicians <u>outside</u> the GME system
- What do we do?
 - Listen, support, and <u>advocate</u> for you! All discussions are <u>confidential</u>
- Situations we can help with:
 - Interpersonal conflicts (resident-resident, resident-attending, etc.)
 - Intrapersonal conflicts (with another department, with leadership)
 - Concerns for unfair/unjust treatment
 - Navigating the GME system
 - Anything and everything!

Situations we have helped with

Academic issues

 Resources to improve clinical performance, test taking, navigate through academic challenges

Personal challenges that affect performance

- Involving friends, family and associates outside of Loma Linda, adjusting to residency
- Medical or legal issues
- Anxiety, stress, depression

Interpersonal interactions at Loma Linda

- Bullying, sexual harassment, interactions that cause a hostile work environment
- Unprofessional communications or interactions

Conflict resolution

 With chief residents, other residents, medical students, fellows, attendings, or any Loma Linda staff- nurses, RCP's, etc.

A resident's story:

- A resident was having multiple issues of a personal nature
 - Relationship, financial, isolation
- These issues grew and led to anxiety, depression, and feelings of failure
- The resident's performance was affected
 - Feedback on rotations from attendings led to feelings of failure
 - The resident became afraid to make decisions
 - The resident started having anxiety and panic attacks
 - Rotation evaluations showed "not meeting expectations"
- The resident developed a crisis at work -> he then sought help

Common reasons residents have for not reaching out for help

- They thought they could handle the situation themselves
- They thought they could ignore the situation
- They were worried it would not remain confidential
- They feared retaliation
- They didn't know what the confidential advisor did
- They didn't know how to get in contact with the confidential advisor

Ultimately, we often hear they wish they had sought help sooner

How to get in touch with us
